	1985	The first bolt-on climbing holds made from concrete resin.
	1986	The first commercial production of Artificial Climbing Structures (A.C.S.) built from wood panels with a high friction laminate resin climbing surface : the CRISTALITHE system.
	1990	Invention of the IMPRINT system : a modular and interchangeable system using polyester panels sculpted in three dimensions. An Entre-Prises' patented product.
	1994	Lillehammer Olympic Games, the first fully articulated ACS ever built.

	2000	Invention of the Explosion Proof System (EPS) for bolt-on climbing holds. An Entre-Prises' patented product. System accredited by the German organisation TÜV.
	2001	Construction of the world's first truly authentic artificial caving complex in South Wales.
	2002	Production of the world's first indoor real ice-climbing structure in The Hague.
	2006	Launch of the MoasïK system : MosaiK is a new construction system allowing the realization of 3D climbing walls. The precision of computer aided manufacturing allows a perfect installation. Wood is FSC certified.
	2007	On January 27th 2007, the IFSC (International Federation of Sport Climbing) was established to govern International Competition Climbing. The same year Entre-Prises signed a partnership with the IFSC to help develop sport climbing on an international level.

## Featured projects

### *Malmö city park , Sweden*

Entre-Prises have recently completed three really striking Freeform boulders in Malmö (Sweden). Inspired by the boulders in Hampi and Fontainebleau they each have their own style, form and colour. A total of 220 m2 of high quality climbing surface provides some of the best climbing opportunities within the city of Malmö.
